



The mission of YCC Family Crisis Center is to “save and change lives” by working to prevent and alleviate domestic violence, sexual assault and homelessness by providing safety, support and resources. Our programs support and enhance the quality of life for all individuals and families by providing advocacy and education as clients find hope on the road to self-sufficiency. Our 62-bed crisis shelter provides a homelike environment to over 500 people a year who must flee their residence due to domestic violence. Each person is provided emergency shelter, bedding, food, clothing, hygiene supplies, and all other basic necessities along with case management support groups, and ongoing advocacy. YCC services extend into supportive housing assistance, advocacy and case management for clients in our community, a sexual assault program, as well as our onsite child care center.
